
### **Kick-Off Event a Grand Success!**

minute additional pledge bringing our total to \$1,000,000 pledged at the time of the event! We are off to a great start.

Now personal outreach will be ongoing, first to a small group who will be asked to prayerfully consider generous, sacrificial, advanced gifts. Those not reached in this phase will be asked for their gift on Commitment Weekend on Sunday, August 27.



# **Financial News**

ur *Rejoice & Renew*Campaign's purpose is to raise the funds required to update and improve our facilities.

A minimum goal of \$2,200,000 has been established, which will enable us to move forward with the most pressing facility and maintenance improvements to the Bell Street property, worship space, & the Family Life Center.

A challenge goal of **\$3,000,000** 

also has been set which, if met, will enable us to make additional enhancements to both properties, presented in the feasibility study, while also earmarking funds for future our deferred major maintenance fund.

Finally, reaching our *praise goal* of **\$4,000,000** will enable us to finish the proposed project without lingering debt.

# **Giving Options**

All members are asked to consider gifts above and beyond what they give in their regular offerings. Gifts can be made in a variety of ways.

#### **Pledges**

Pledges payable over three years are easier for many people, enable most to make larger gifts than they otherwise might outright, and are, therefore, essential to meeting our goal. Gifts may be made in monthly, quarterly, semi-annual, or annual installments at the donor's discretion. A 10% initial investment toward your total pledge is encouraged.

#### **Non-Cash Gifts**

Non-cash gifts are an additional or alternative way you can support our cause. You may, for example, wish to consider *in-kind* gifts such as labor and materials; gifts of securities, such as stocks and bonds; gifts of real estate; or even personal property, such as artwork, automobiles, jewelry, and antiques.

### **Deferred Gifts**

Deferred gifts are another option you may wish to consider. These are gifts that can be given or arranged for now, but will not be received until later. They include gifts through a person's will by bequest, gifts of life insurance policies or annuities, and gifts in trust.

# **Giving Opportunities**

here are a number of very special gift opportunities within our campaign available to donors or groups of donors of qualifying gift amounts. These opportunities allow people the unique chance to associate their gifts with a particular portion of the campaign and honor or memorialize one or more people of their choosing as part of their special gift pledge.

\*Gift amounts do not necessarily reflect the item's exact cost. Rather, they are based on the item's prominence, our needs, and our community's gift abilities. Gift contributions may be made over the entire three-year giving period. Recognition will be given when the gift is received in full.
