## **Sermon series for September** and October: The Seven Solae

October 31, 2017 is the 500th anniversary of the day that Martin Luther nailed his 95 theses against the Catholic Church up on the church door in Wittenberg.

The early reformers put forth three foundational principles of reformation known as the "Solae." This list has been added onto since, bringing it to seven: Sola Scriptura (only scripture), Sola Gratia (only grace), Sola Fide (only faith), Solus Christus (only Christ), Soli Deo gloria (glory to God alone), Sola ecclesia (the Church alone) and Sola caritas (charitable love alone).

Today we are celebrating Reformation Sunday on October 29. Leading up to this date, we have been using one of these Solae each week, along with a Lectionary scripture reading, as a theme for our worship services.


