### **Shopping Plaza Parking Alert**

We were made aware that, even on Sundays, we are only allowed to park in spaces in the Village Shopping Plaza lot that are marked for 2 -hour or public parking. Our cars will be ticketed on any day at any time if we park in yellow-lined spaces designated by signs that read, "Plaza Employee Permit Parking Only."

In the Darfur Region of Sudan, a 20-year civil war killed two million people and displaced four million. 20,000 boys lost their families and were forced to flee.

They wandered hundreds of miles across the desert, and

ended up in a Kenyan refugee camp where they spent ten years of their life. 4,000 of these "Lost Boys" have come to America as part of a refugee resettlement effort.
