GROUP Work Camp Fund

Hello Church Family,

We would like to invite you to become a work camp teammate for our summer trip to St. Ignace, MI. where we will be working with the Native Americans of the Mackinac Island Band of Ottawa and Chippewa. We've never committed to a work camp with such great need and no resources for materials. Our request is that you donate, if so led, to a Facebook fund set up for this purpose by Friday, May 11.

Our work campers will work on converting a house that the band owns into a much needed community center. They have no place to meet for their ceremonies and ancient rituals, which are deeply set in their spirituality and faith. There is also no place for them to gather to hear and pass on the stories of their elders, whom they revere and love. Huge portions of their story are lost with the passing of each elder and they are hoping that this center will allow more cultural transmission, as well as fellowship. SJAM May Movie Night


