

His thoughts about the new organ and Chancel area – "...Wow! The new [Chancel area] configuration is going to be fabulous! I think you'll be very pleased with the results. It's a significant change to the whole front of the Sanctuary, which ought to aid music making in a big way. By the way, the new Rodgers console is... at the showroom... It is beautiful! It will sound even better!



"We'll want to spend a significant amount of time learning how to use it.

This is where I am at your service for as long as you need. You will love the ease with which you can control such a large instrument... Heck, the record and playback feature by itself is a revelation. Imagine, you'll be able to register your prelude, record it, and then go out into the Sanctuary to hear it exactly as everyone else does. That alone will be an education in organ registration...."

Bethel provides auditory and visual tools to help you establish a sound Biblical knowledge involving emphasis on key Biblical concepts and

corresponding lessons. Bethel Bible Study requires a discipline and commitment from September—May, with a break during the holidays. The first year covers the Old Testament, and the second year covers the New Testament. Times of the class will be tailored to meet the needs of the students (maximum 20).


