## Introducing Rev. Naviri Kariian

Today we welcome Rev. Nayiri Karjian, the General Minister of Eastern Ohio and Western Reserve Associations of Ohio

Conference UCC as our guest minister.

She is an Armenian, born and raised in Aleppo, Syria, who grew up in the Armenian Protestant Church, a mission partner of the UCC. She earned a BA from Haigazian University, and a Certificate in Theology from the Near East School of Theology, both in Beirut, Lebanon. Her application process to attend Lancaster Theological seminary in Lancaster, PA was launched in 1980 during the Lebanese civil war. Nayiri arrived in the US on August 26, 1982 and graduated from Lancaster Theological Seminary with a Master of Divinity in 1985.

Since her ordination in 1985 Nayiri has served UCC congregations in settled and interim/ transitional capacities in Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, Illinois, Connecticut, Texas, Missouri, Tennessee, and Colorado. Nayiri believes that the Church has no geographical boundaries, and is called to be a community of grace and healing, and to embody Christ in the world.

Nayiri embraces the mystical path of faith as she believes that the Spirit resides in each of us and that God is not an other but is within and without, connecting us to one another in the allencompassing Spirit out of which nothing exists. Her expertise is in teaching and renewing practices for church health, well being, and vitality.


Prayer will be led by a different clergy each week. This week's leader is Rev. Lisa O'Rear from St. Andrews Episcopal Church in Mentor.


### **HELP WANTED!**
