
Marge Adler is relied upon by colleagues across North America for her collaborative skills, keyboard mastery and eclectic approach. Known as a "treasure with at least three hands," Marge was co-composer with the late Tom Luckay and music director for *If Chagrin Could Sing*, a CD of original songs about Chagrin Falls. She has collaborated in concert with David Cangelosi of the Metropolitan Opera and with Phillip Boykin of renown on Broadway. There were days in which Marge would change hats on I-71, after serving as

organist for a
Cleveland Indians
game, to become
harpsichordist for
the Bach Festival at
Baldwin Wallace
University.

Marge wrote and performed the



musical score for the locally produced film, *Exact* Change, which was featured at the Chagrin Documentary Film Festival. Recently she served a residency as Guest Musical Director for St. Francis by the Lake Episcopal Church (Canyon Lake, TX), and as Guest Collaborative Artist for Cleveland Opera Theater's anniversary tribute to Leonard Bernstein.
