Properties Feasibility Task Force– Letter and O&A Sessions

Members and friends of Federated Church received in the mail this week a letter from Church Council. The letter explains the Council's decision, arrived at after a recommendation from the Properties Feasibility Task Force, to engage a commercial real estate agent to prepare a sale prospectus for our Family Life Center, exploring prices and options for that facility and grounds. Please read that letter and learn the Council's thinking. And then let the Council know your thoughts and reactions.

There will be numerous opportunities to let the Council know your reactions. Properties Feasibility Task Force and Council members are in the process of spending time with ministry teams and commissions. Each Sunday, there will be two opportunities to engage in conversation, at 10:30 and 11:15 am in the Chapel.

On Sunday, June 23 at 12:30 pm, there will be a congregational meeting to affirm Council's vote on the proposal to engage the realtor. Then in the fall, once the realtor has presented us with possible options, there will be a congregational vote on how to proceed. Please learn about the issues and come to any session to let your thoughts and feelings be known. Then join us June 23 for the meeting and vote.

TODAY | 1:00—6:00 pm | Family Life Center


