There will be numerous opportunities to let the Council know your reactions. Properties Feasibility Task Force and Council members are in the process of spending time with ministry teams and commissions. Today, there will be an opportunity to engage in conversation after worship at 11 am in the Hearth Room.

On Sunday, June 23 at 12:30 pm, there will be a congregational meeting to affirm Council's vote on the proposal to engage the realtor. Then in the fall, once the realtor has presented us with possible options, there will be a congregational vote on how to proceed. Please learn about the issues and come to any session to let your thoughts and feelings be known. Then join us June 23 for the meeting and vote.


Pilgrimage to the Holy Land Information Session
