Pick up your small water bottle and card from the baskets outside the Sanctuary doors and at the Reception Desk in the Bell St. Lobby.



Spirituality." It is a program where people gather casually in a local pub to discuss intriguing questions about life, spirituality or theology.

An example of prepared questions might be: "What drains life from you, and what replenishes it?" or "Why does God allow pain and suffering?" or "What do you believe about the afterlife?" This is also a wonderful program to which to invite your un-churched family and friends, of any faith.

All we ask is that participants:

- *agree to be respectful of all opinions, even if you disagree.
- * remember that there is no wrong answer.
- * agree not to interrupt one another.
- * agree to monitor how long they talk so there is time for everyone.

We will be meeting at **Burntwood Tavern in Chagrin from 6-8 pm**. Everyone will have a separate check and can order dinner or just beverages or whatever you want. A 20% gratuity will apply. **We'll meet every other Monday: June 17, July 1, July 15 and July 29.**

Strengthen the Church Special UCC Offering


To be collected June 9
