Exonerees: Nancy Smith, Raymond Towler Reed Pierce: Program Director for policy, legislation and education for the Ohio Innocence Project at the University of Cincinnati College of Law

The Ohio Innocence Project at Cincinnati Law (University of Cincinnati) has one simple goal: free every innocent person in Ohio who has been convicted of a crime they did not commit. Since its inception, OIP's work has led to the release of 28 wrongfully convicted Ohioans, who collectively served over 525 years behind bars. Two of these

exonerees will join us to discuss the significance art (visual and musical) had on their lives in prison.

Pick up your small water bottle and card from the baskets outside the Sanctuary doors and at the Reception Desk in the Bell St. Lobby.




New Location for Spirits & Spirituality
