## Strengthen the Church Special UCC Offering

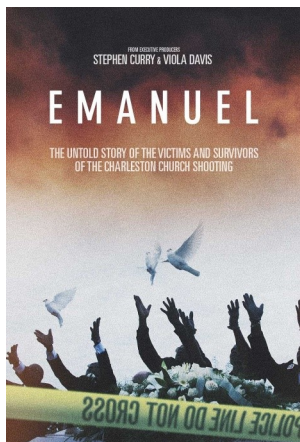

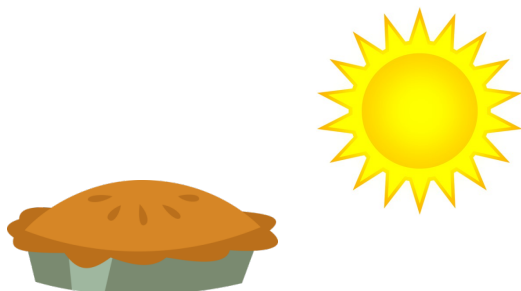
