The Movie: "Poisoned Water"

Join our Social Justice Advocacy Ministry (SJAM) as we watch a documentary that outlines what

really happened in the community of Flint, Michigan.

The water crisis there was an environmental issue, a racial justice issue, an issue of poverty, an issue of health, and an issue of trust and honesty.

Five years ago, the city of Flint switched its water to the Flint River. Citizens soon complained of dirty, foul-smelling water. Doctors found evidence of high lead levels in children.

Outside researchers proved the city's water (because of a lack of corrosion control) was corroding pipes, bacteria levels skyrocketed, and thousands of people were without clean water. And throughout this process, the city officials said everything was fine.

## **Capital Campaign & Projects Update**

Last month, a group of folks met to determine: Capital Campaign Projects - Where Are We Now? Keith Mast, Becky Gruss, Amy Eugene, Laura Taylor, and Janis Stefanchik met to make sure that we are keeping track of all campaign payments that are coming in, campaign bills that are being paid, and the progress of each capital campaign project that was approved by Church Council. We are blessed that after 1 ¾ years, the church has already received more than 86% of the cash pledged during the capital campaign. You made this happen and we are grateful!

At this point in the *Rejoice & Renew capital* campaign, funds currently received are being used this fall or winter for capital projects, including:

- installing walk-off pads to protect our new carpet at all entrances,
- reupholstering/refurbishing Conference Room/Sanctuary chairs,
- continuing transition to LED lightbulbs,
- · repairing westside concrete steps and sidewalk,
- updating audio/visual capabilities at the Family Life Center replace an old unit with the one formerly used in the Sanctuary and convert to mobile,
- installing a key card entry system at Bell Street, and
- replenishing our Deferred Major Maintenance Fund (it's like a Rainy Day Fund used when major items at our facilities unexpectedly break.)

Members on the Finance Committee and the Properties Committee, as well as the church operations staff, will continue to meet to make sure that we remain good stewards of the capital campaign payments that are still coming in.

that the kids can play with. Last year, we were able to send a few bikes and toys that have been in constant use by the children since. Sturdy, uncomplicated bikes are best. We will fix them up before sending them, if needed.

## **Recycling at Federated**

The rules have changed! Here are the very few things that are recyclable:











Aluminum cans and lids, cartons, glass bottles, paper/cardboard, plastic bottles/jugs

The following things are *not* recyclable:

Paper coffee cups, stirrer sticks and straws, yogurt cups, plastic utensils, plastic bags, zipper storage bags, plastic wrap, aluminum foil, glassware (ex. flower vases)

Make sure your items are clean and dry with caps on tight. Please do not "wish-cycle" and put items in the bin hoping they will be recycled. That does not work and contaminates everything else in the recycling bin. When in doubt, throw it out!
