
A Wondrous Wednesday Event



complete the baskets. Please make checks payable to Federated Church with "Ingathering" in the memo. Let's celebrate our blessings by sharing from our abundance!


Save the Date for Advent by Candlelight: A Cup of Christmas Tea An Invitation for Women to Prepare for Christ's Coming
