

JOY (Jr. High Youth Group) and GROUP (Sr. High Youth Group) Update

Our youth have been busy this fall! JOY took a walking field trip to Whitesburg Park on a photojournaling outing - looking at the watershed in our area and discovering what looks to be good and bad for our precious Lake Erie. This led up to a volunteering experience at the West Creek Conservancy in October. In September, they kicked off a used bike and book collection for an orphanage in Losotho, Africa.

In the meantime, our GROUP kids came up with ideas for decorating Room 340, expressed lots of interest in service activities, shared stories about themselves, and found common



ground games. Recent discussions included God's role in art and creativity while making vision boards for inspiration, followed by a scavenger hunt in town. And at the end of October, GROUP served a meal at St. Paul's Loaves and Fishes program and had about 10 kids, which was awesome! Confirmation Class began last Sunday and is underway with five students.

In recent weeks, 12 kids and parents joined the advisors and Marty, Director of Youth Faith Formation, to create a space in Room 340 that is youth appropriate and friendly. They will be getting a TV monitor and mounting a huge whiteboard soon.

Stewardship: Stamps

It's been a fun and meaningful exercise to incorporate our fall liturgical theme into the Stewardship Campaign this season. And just to add the perfect ending to our water theme, look what Melinda Smith, our Congregational Life Administrator, found at the post office for the Stewardship Committee - beautiful stamps depicting some of our Wild and Scenic Rivers! Each winter the Committee mails thank you notes to those in our faith family who have pledged funds to the church for the following year and we'll love using these stamps!

Pledging shines a light on our personal priorities - and defines the church's budget, which is based only on pledges received. And through those pledges, we become stewards of peace and possibility, deliberately giving over our lives and our resources to something larger than ourselves. We are

pleased to say that, at this point, the 2020 Ministry Investment Plan is 55% funded, with 209 pledges received. Follow-up calls – affectionately known as chase calls - will begin soon, so if you have not yet turned in your completed pledge card, we encourage you to do so now. In both receiving and sharing God's abundance, we take God's outstretched hand and are led into healing waters. Join us in taking God's outstretched hand!


