

# Week I (12/1) Hope in the midst of hopelessness

(Scripture: Isaiah 2:1-5)

Begin preparation November 25 with spiritual practice of **Gratitude**. You are encouraged to begin each day with the intention of being aware of where you see hope. Be grateful for those people, places and things, and perhaps even journal about them. There is hope in this world, but often we are too blinded by hopelessness to notice. Making it a practice to notice hope in the world enables us to better become that hope for others.
