
Week II (12/8) Peace in the midst of conflict (Scripture: Isaiah 11:1-10)

Begin each day with the praying of the reflection, and then spending some time in quiet contemplation. Ideal time is twenty minutes of silence, focusing on a sacred word, and releasing all thoughts. Spend however much time is comfortable for you centering yourself by resting in the arms of your loving God, and carrying that peace with you.
