## Intermuseum Conservation Association: An Extra Primetime Trip! Wednesday, January 8

Primetime will be touring one of Ohio City's best -kept secrets. The Intermuseum Conservation Association (ICA) is home to a small staff dedicated to conserving and preserving some of the most historic cultural artifacts in the Midwest and around the world. It's the oldest nonprofit regional art conservation center in the country. It is a climate-controlled facility that is equal parts art museum, mad scientist lab and high-tech invention test site! The entire 6,000-square-foot second floor is an open workroom, loosely divided into sections where teams work on paintings, objects, textiles and paper.

After our tour we will have lunch at The Harp. It's an Irish pub that serves delicious "Boxty Cakes," their famous Irish potato pancake folded over and stuffed with delicious fillings!
