A Message From Church Council: 2019 Annual Meeting of the Congregation

Throughout most of 2019, the Church Council and appointed task forces have spent time in discovery and research regarding the Family Life Center. In November, a letter went out to the congregation with summaries of reports from the "Additional Possibilities Task Force" and the "Real Estate Task Force."

In December, four listening sessions were held. Congregation members were invited to hear the task force presentations in person and to ask questions and share thoughts about the ideas. These questions were gathered and became part of the ongoing work. A combined group from the task forces, the Joint Task Force Recommendation Team, began meeting to look for a way to pursue the new use idea, proposed by an emerging non-profit, in a way that accomplished the financial goals needed for sustainability.

Church Council plans to bring a recommendation with information to the congregation at the Annual Meeting on February 23 at 12:45 pm. <u>Your presence is important!</u> We need a quorum of 100 members to approve the 2020 budget and candidates for leadership positions throughout the church and the recommendation brought forth by Church Council.

A meal will be provided prior to the meeting, starting at 11:00 am, benefitting the Colorado Kids.
