 owls have a unique mating ritual where they meet in the air, connect talons,

- The little falcon we met was called Baby Bear and he was blind in his right eye. When they fly against the wind it looks like they are hovering.
- Another cool fact the peregrine falcon can fly over 240 miles per hour!

We need to come up with activities to do at home so maybe it's a good time to read or watch "North and South" or to go online and watch reruns of the Carol Burnett show with Tim Conway! We all need a good laugh right now.
