#### **RALLY DAY CELEBRATION**

#### NEXT SUNDAY, September 13 | Family Life Center starting at 12:00 pm

"While we can't be together as we'd like to be – we can come together to feed our community!" This is the theme of our Rally Day celebration this year.

While the pandemic prevents us from gathering in person, we are hosting an alternative Rally Day that will celebrate our wide array of ministries and enable us to respond to the food needs of our community. In addition to helping our congregation connect, we will be helping the food ministries of Chagrin Falls Park and the Bainbridge Food for Friends.

Items needed include: Mac-n-cheese, SpaghettiOs, rice, pancake mix and syrup, flour, sugar, saltine crackers, cookies, peanut butter, dried beans, toilet paper, tissues, toothpaste, shampoo, toothbrushes, deodorant, dishwashing liquid, bar soap, disinfecting spray and wipes. We'll also assist these organizations with monetary donations. Mark your donation as "Rally Day."

Members are asked to drive to the Rally at the Family Life Center starting at noon where they will pass by the display of banners that celebrate the ministries of our church and proceed to the food trailer where they can place their donations for the hunger centers.

We are also creating a montage of messages from our members and families and asking each to bring a letter size sheet with your family names and a short message of love, faith or hope for our times. Artistic embellishments are encouraged, but not necessary. You can also submit electronic versions to communications@fedchurch.org. We will place these in the Sanctuary pews for Hamilton to see while he is preaching.

After dropping off your food and message, cars will gather in the parking lot for a short program that will begin at 12:30 pm from Council and our commissions to update you on how our ministries have been carrying on in the midst of the pandemic and what our plans are for the future. You will be able to hear the program through an FM station in your car radio!

Even though we will only be able to greet each other from our cars, the gathering will give us a chance to see one another and to be reminded that we are still the church – still recipients of grace – still called to follow in the way of Christ our Lord. It will feel good to be TOGETHER!
