To celebrate the achievements of women our monthly movie will be the film "Ida B. Wells: A Passion for Justice" which documents the dramatic life and turbulent times of the pioneering African American journalist, activist, suffragist, and anti-lynching crusader of the post-Reconstruction period.



Though virtually forgotten today, Ida B. Wells was a

household name in Black America during much of her lifetime (1863-1931) and was considered the equal of such well-known contemporary African American leaders as Booker T. Washington and W.E.B. DuBois. Nobel Prize-winning author, Toni Morrison reads selections from Wells' memoirs and other writings in this multi-award winning film.
