Presenter: Mary Lou Smullen The History of Christmas Ornaments

Mary Lou Smullen was born and raised in the Cleveland area. She graduated from Orange High School and Ohio University. In 1975 she entered the United States Army via a Direct Commission. One military tour took her to Frankfurt, Germany for 4 years. She loved the way the Germans celebrated Christmas and found her beloved "Pyramid" while flea market shopping there.

Upon her retirement after 20 years of service, she was gifted her great-uncle's small ornament collection. The Pyramid and the ornaments were the catalysts for her passion of vintage and antique Christmas collecting. Moving back to Cleveland about 3 years ago, required her to downsize her collection by about 80%. She kept those things she loved the most and especially enjoys her vintage and antique glass ornament collection.

Her presentation will feature a history of glass ornaments and examples of their evolution thru the centuries.
