Presenter: Dewey Forward The Chagrin Falls Popcorn Shop

Dewey Forward, owner of the iconic Chagrin Falls Popcorn Shop, isn't about to retire. His entrepreneurial spirit showed itself when he was 8 years old and started a canteen in his basement.

Dewey grew up in Shaker Heights, graduated from University School, attended college and ended up in Hartford, Connecticut with some buddies. They purchased a 3000-seat concert hall. The venture lasted seven months and Dewey said he "learned a lot and failed a lot".

He returned to N E Ohio and opened Peabody's Café in Cleveland Heights in 1977 and then Peabody's Down Under in the Flats in 1981. The business was sold in 1996. Dewey began thinking about his next chapter. That's when the Popcorn Shop came into his life.

Dewey was friends with Mort McClennan whose mother started the Popcorn Shop in the 1940s.

In 2000, a van crashed into the store forcing it to close. Dewey got involved, gutted the building, and created a new layout. The shop has been successful ever since it reopened. Dewey credits our community with the success, saying the people who visit love the shop and are very protective of it.

Sooo, come hear Dewey recall the wonderful history of the Popcorn Shop that we all love.
