Lakeview Cemetery and Daffodil Hill

Thursday, April 7, 9:15 AM–3:00 PM

We will arrive at the Lakeview Cemetery at 10:00, and, if available, a docent will board our bus for a 2-hour tour of the cemetery. We will see the graves of many famous people there, such as Eliot Ness, Carl Stokes, and John D. Rockefeller, to name a few, in addition to the Jephtha Wade Chapel.

Wade Memorial Chapel was built in memory of Jephtha Wade, founder of the Western Union Telegraph Company, and the first president of Lake View Cemetery. It is also listed on the National Register of Historic Places. It is one of the few interiors in the world that was totally designed by Louis Comfort Tiffany and his studios.

The highlight of the trip should be Daffodil Hill, which will hopefully be in full bloom, weather cooperating! After our tour, we will eat at Guarino's in Little Italy! YUM! (Lunch is On your own).

In retirement, she has become very busy with volunteer groups in Chagrin, acting as Chair of the Parks Commission, Co-Chair of the Beautification Committee for the downtown garden beds and urns, and Secretary for the Friends of the Chagrin Falls Library. She is also an elder on Session at the Church of the Covenant (Presbyterian) on Euclid Avenue across from University Hospitals and an active member of the Village Garden Club in Shaker Heights where the group maintains a grove of flowering trees next to Horseshoe Lake. This uproarious romantic thriller will end this memorable season with two things the audiences loves - laughter and suspense!

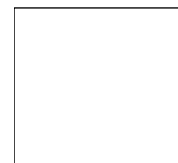
