The Mission & Service Commission is participating in JustHope's \$31,000 Truck of Hope initiative, hoping to raise \$16,000 of their goal here at Federated. Their community truck has broken down beyond repair. This initiative will save lives and community programs:

“A functioning vehicle saves the lives of so many within our community. While we are without a vehicle, our doctors are still making house calls, but they need to walk from home to home, limiting the number of visits and the instruments they can take with them. In addition, the staff of our community organization now must use public transportation to run our errands, which takes double the time and limits the work we can do.”
